

CARE – CHILDREN AT RISK OF EXPLOITATION

The CARE team provides specialist support to children and young people aged 8-24 years who are victims, or at risk of Child Sexual Exploitation (CSE) across Essex.

Individual and group therapeutic work with children and young people to provide support and understanding to ensure they receive a needs led service, helping them to move forward, increase their emotional wellbeing and keep them safe.

Advice and guidance for parents and carers, enabling them to provide safe environments within the family context. We also provide signposting and can work with transitioning families into additional support where required.

Confidentiality

CARE aims to offer all clients a confidential service. This means that we do not share information that you have told us without there being a necessary need to do so or without your prior consent.

Information sharing

This service is signed up to The Whole Essex Information Sharing Framework which includes members from a range of agencies.

We will share information relevant to safeguarding as necessary and as allowed by legislation.

Data will be shared regularly as required, and in particular to support:

- * Requirements of the Essex Safeguarding Children Board and the Essex Safeguarding Adults Board meetings.
- * At the point of any referral into the Joint Domestic Abuse Triage Team.
- * Multi-Agency Risk Assessment Conference (MARAC)
- * Multi-Agency Public Protection Arrangements (MAPPA)
- * Agreed emergency planning protocols
- * Any inspection regimes, timescales and requests.
